Since 1937, Camp Yarramundi has shaped generations of children, families and communities through outdoor education and connection to nature. In 2028, a reimagined Camp Yarramundi opens its doors as a fully accessible, purpose-built outdoor education and events centre.

Set on the banks of the World Heritage-listed Grose River, Camp Yarramundi takes its name from Yarramundi, a garadyi of the Boorooberongal clan of the Dharug people. Today, the camp continues to be a place for connection, learning and shared experience on Country.

A **new** conference and events centre for shared moments, study retreats, arts and music programs

Camp Yarramundi is one of the most accessible outdoor education sites in NSW designed from the ground up so no one is left on the sidelines.



Wheelchair-accessible site, including high and low ropes, giant swing, flying fox and archery



Adaptable abseiling, renewed river access and inclusive water activities



12 dedicated accessible cabins with accessible bathrooms



Support for people with limited mobility, low vision or hearing, intellectual disability and neurodiversity
